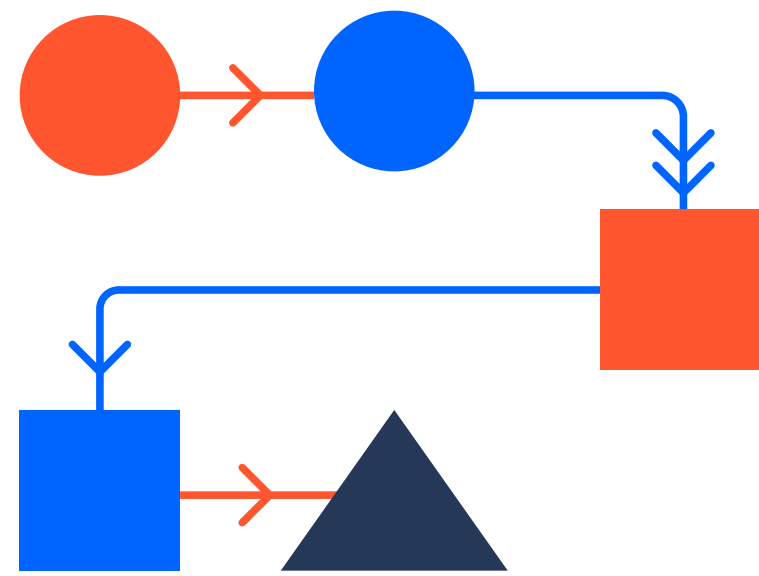

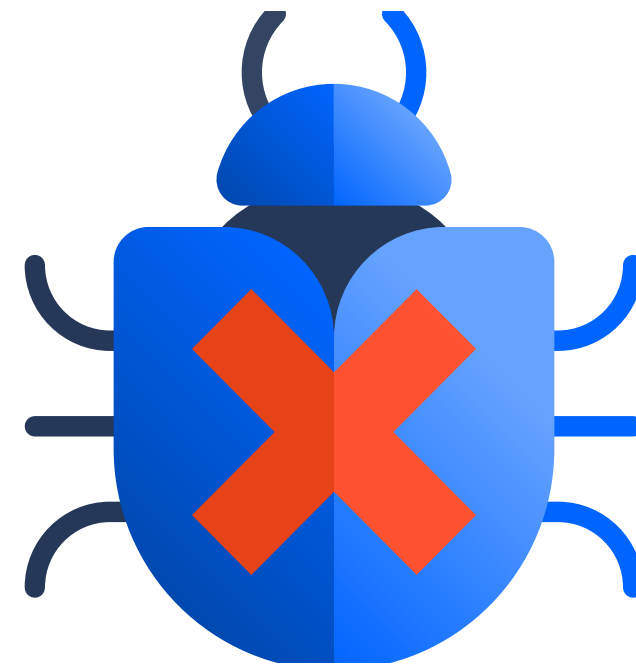

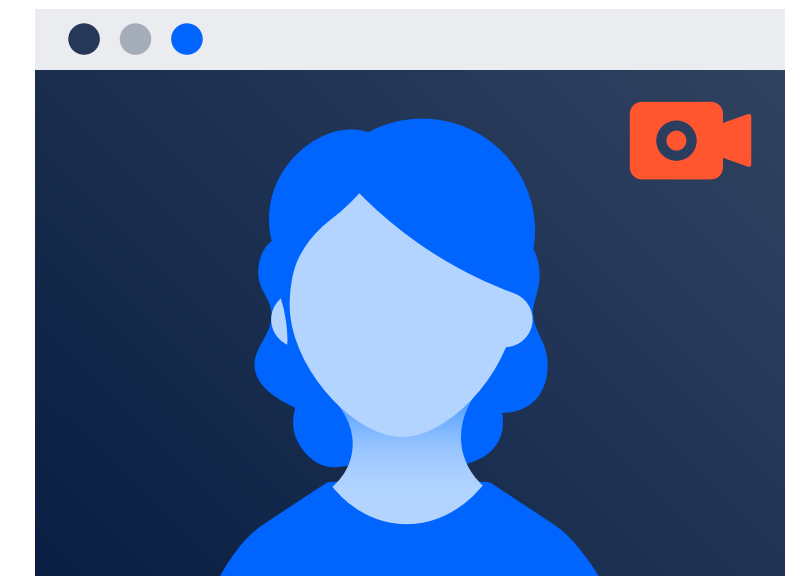
Dev Workflow

Communication policies and rules, instead of constant interruption and lack of planning

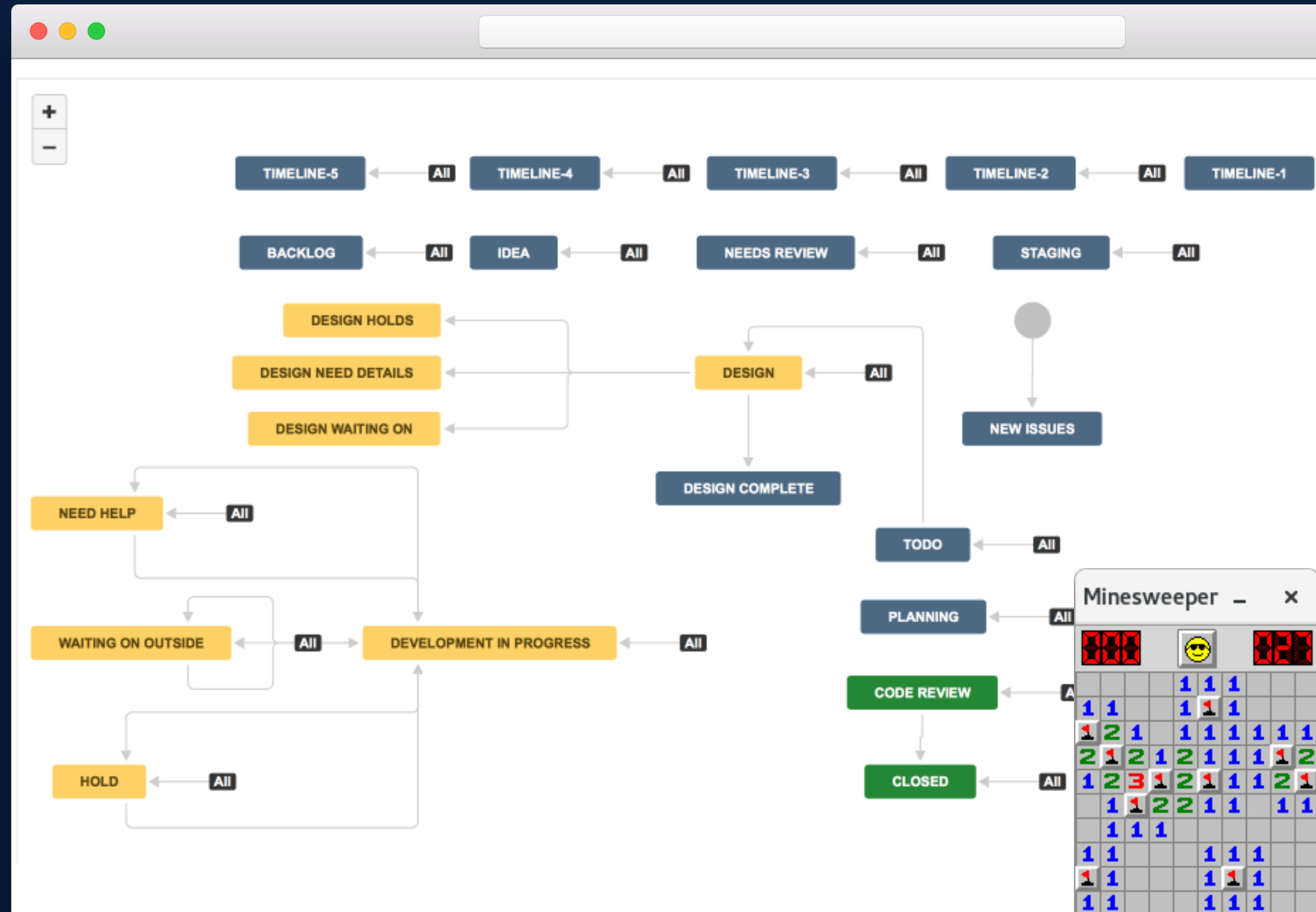

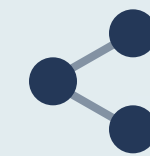
Removing Scrum

Or rather moving from pseudo-scrum, since given the workload specifics we couldn't achieve uninterrupted development



On Call teams

Creating on duty teams to handle urgent bugfixing



Mentorship

Removing functional silos via mentorship, even if it takes more time



Rotation for On Call teams

To prevent burning out



Requirements

Pain Points



Consistency & Standards

There was no consistent description for similar tasks



Scope Creeps

Tickets were often sent back due to changes / requests or edge-cases missing

Distribution amplifies pain points

Being some cozy agile
team can fix bad
requirements, but time
and distance amplify
negativity dramatically

Less is more

Categorize issue types you use, and limit project to them only. Standardize the requirements and fields for each of them -> achieve consistency

WHOLE NEW PROJECT FOR REQUIREMENTS

Visibility

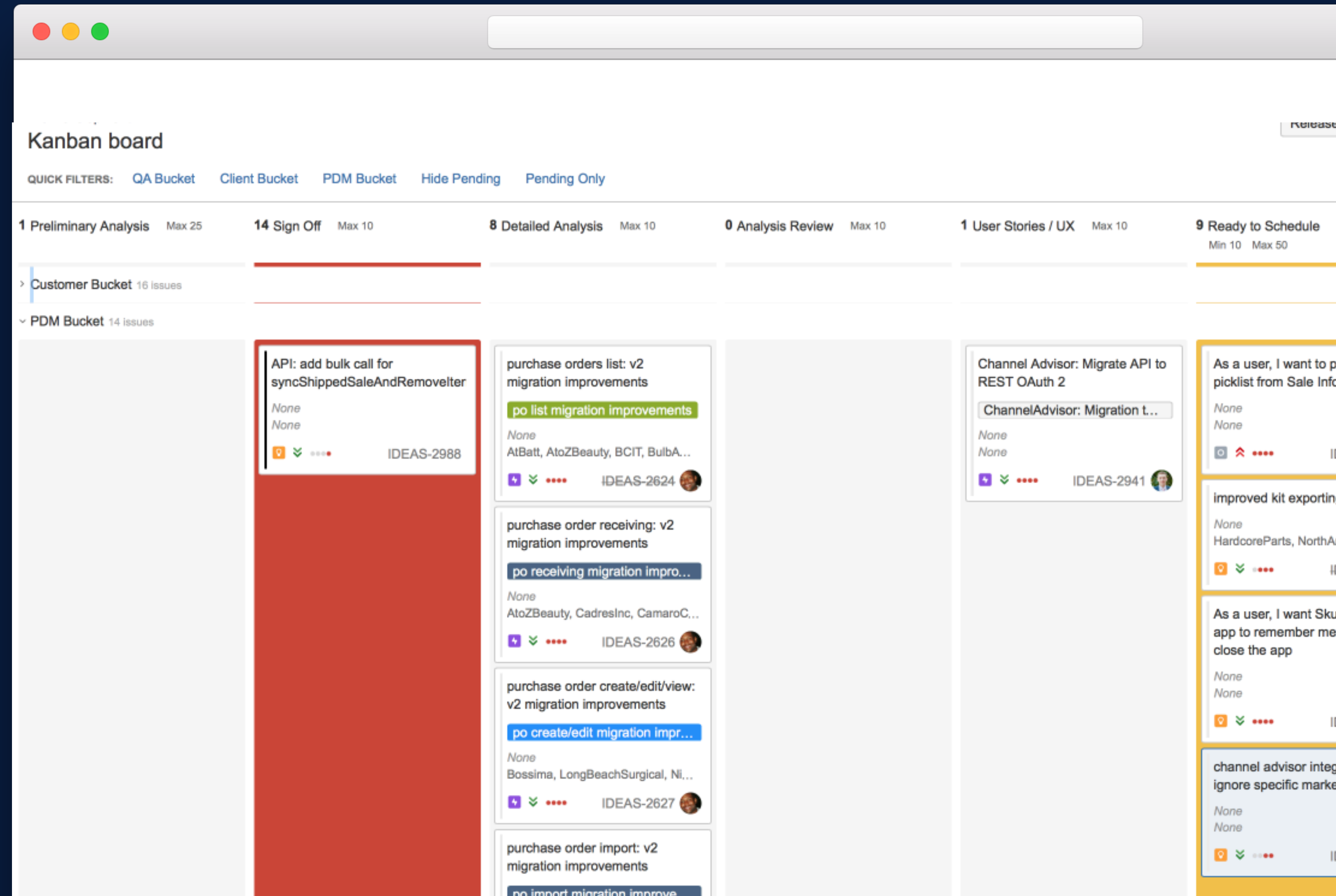
On the status of your new feature, even for people outside of product team

Ownership

Sole owner for each status, which helps not only in transparency, but also in finding bottlenecks

Separate project

Meaning that details and edge-cases are hashed out, passed acceptance and previewed before implementing





On Call Teams provide coverage, safety from distractions, speed

When using: rotate, set description standards, provide clear workflow - get +10 in survival

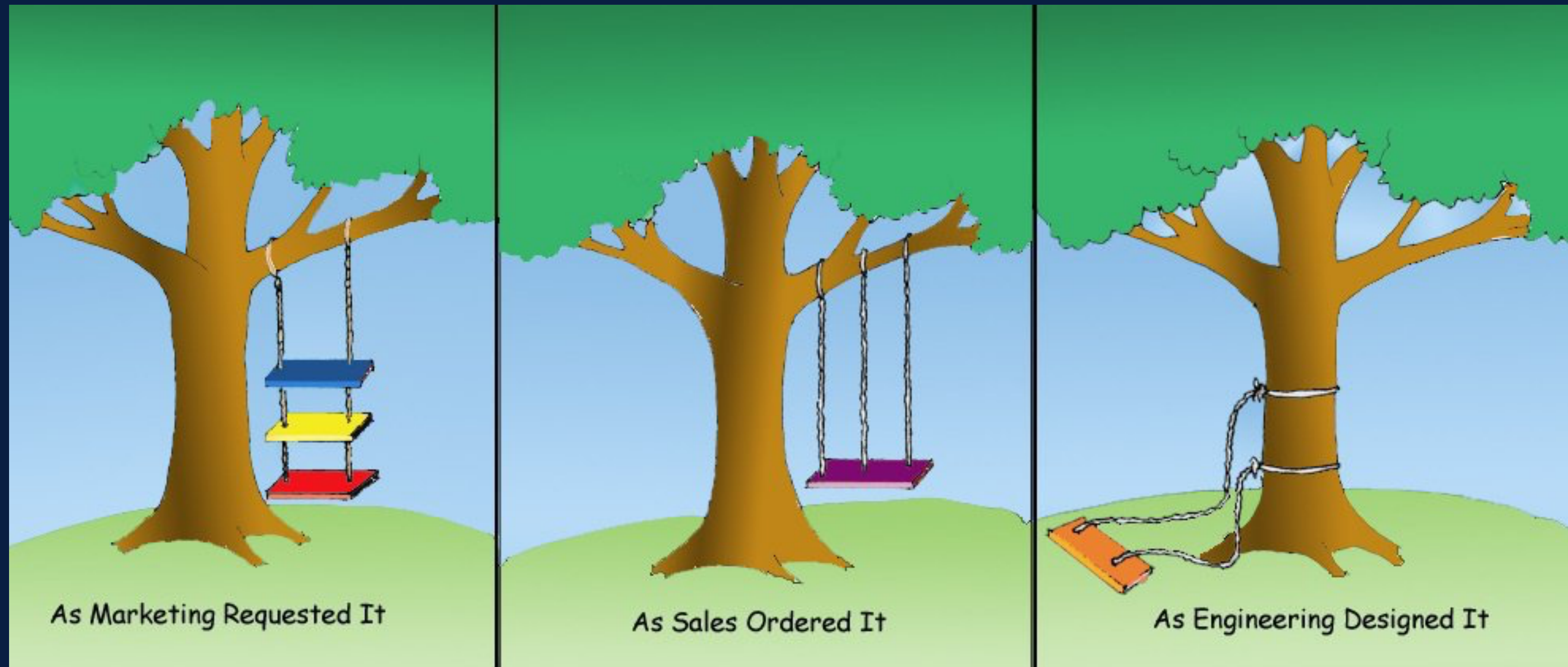

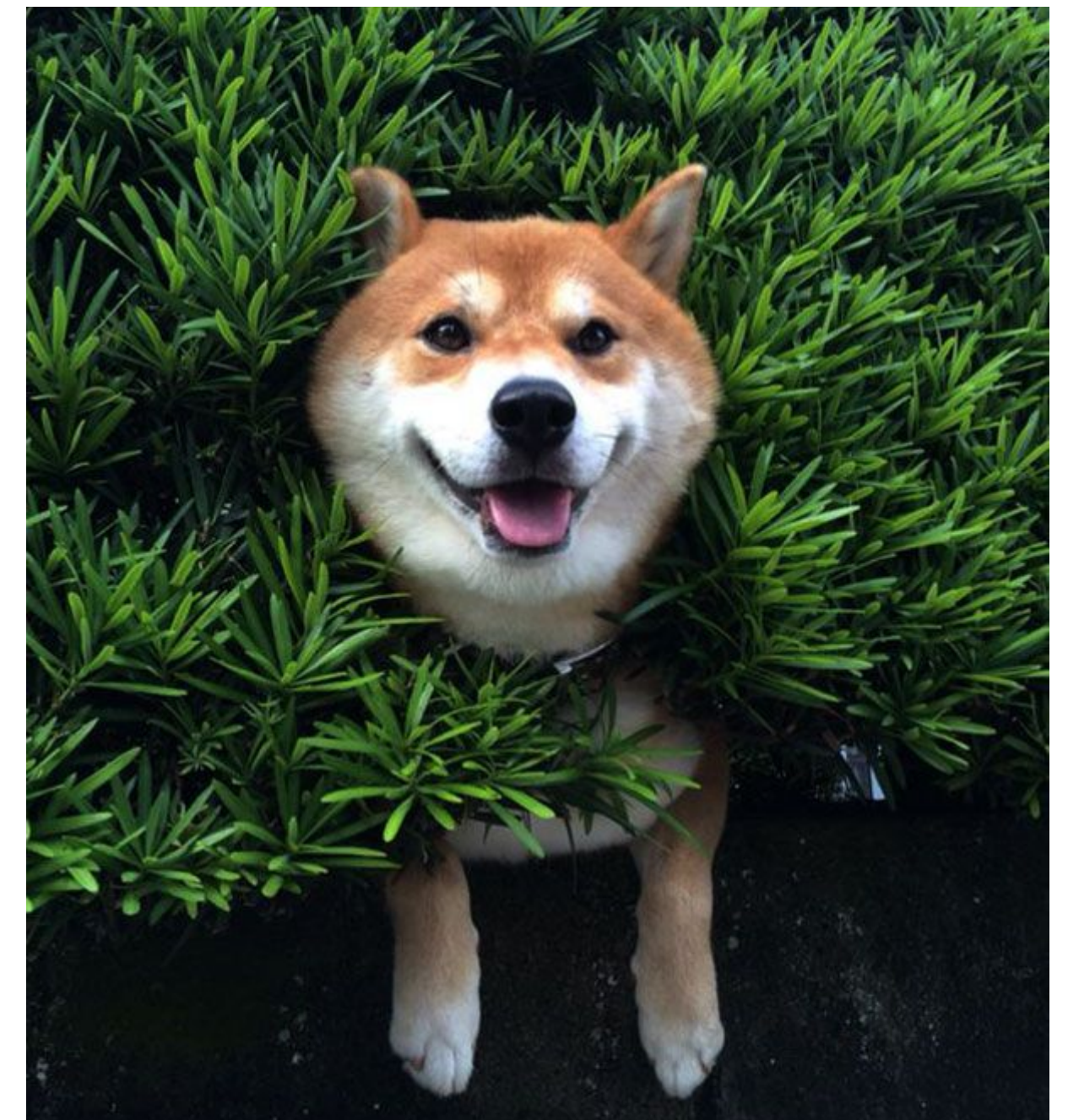

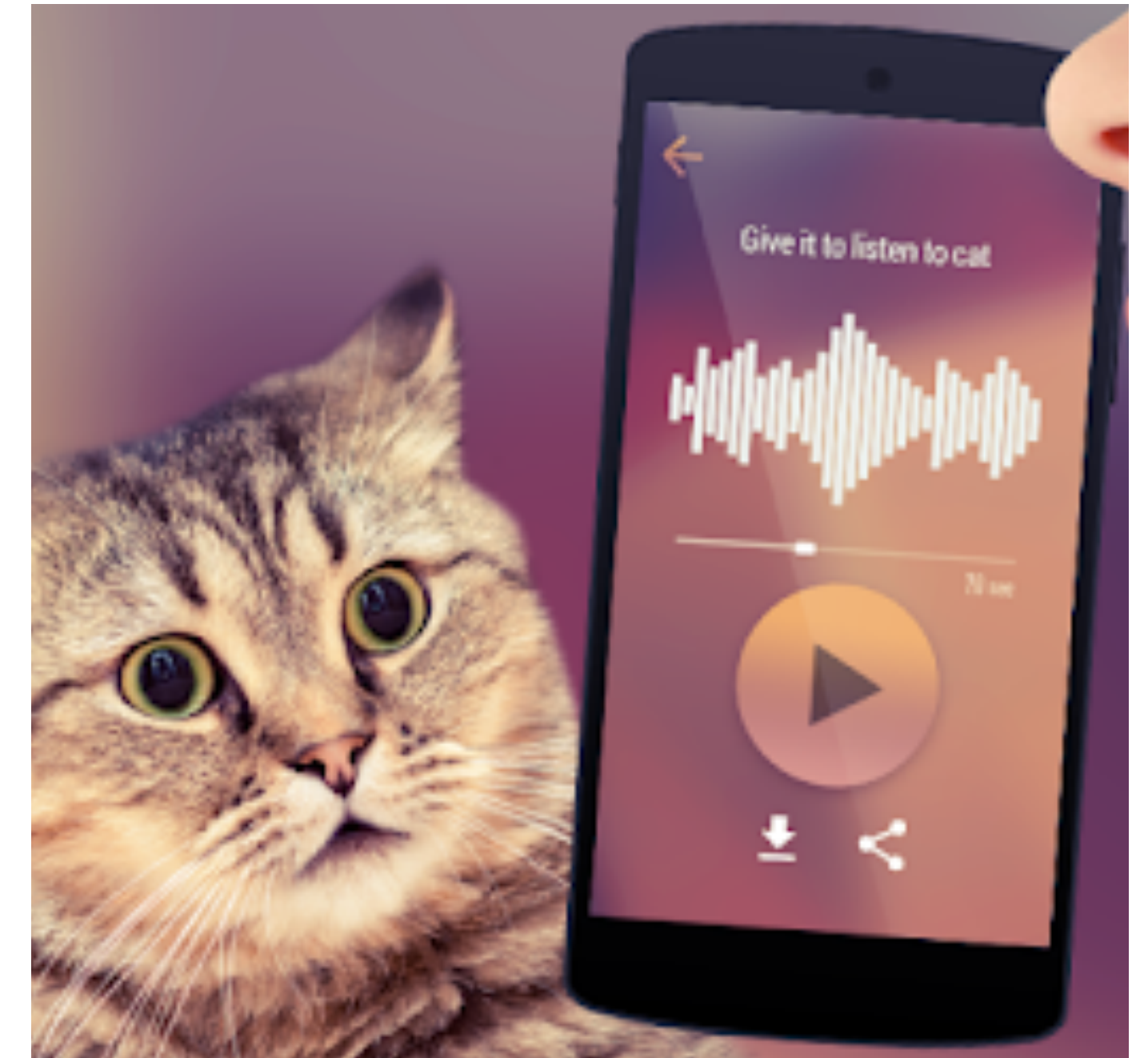

Language Barrier

Painful. Do overcommunicate, overdocument, precise. And always have an agenda and let people prepare beforehand.



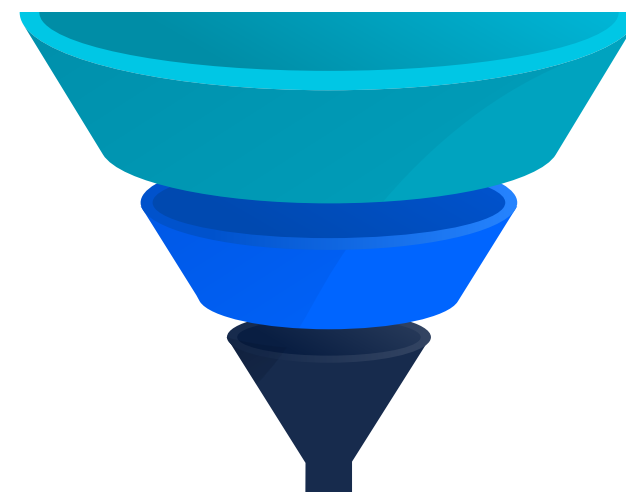

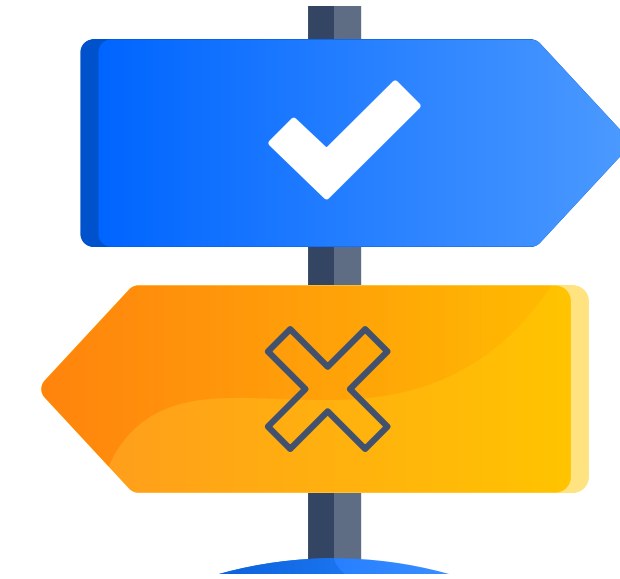
Respect

Because distribution deals with timing, geography and culture



Focus

Less is more, stay focused. Don't disperse, inspect the bottlenecks.



Streamlining

The more straightforward the workflow is - the better. Make complex simpler!
